Many devotees are doing “shramdaan” to keep the Mandir clean. However, as informed in the last newsletter, Mandir needs deep cleaning so that devotees can maintain the basic cleaning.

Therefore, we have hired a cleaning company to clean the Bathroom, Common and Bhandara area thoroughly once a week. We will reassess if more areas need to be routinely cleaned.



Meeting at the Embassy of India

The newly appointed Samiti was invited to the Indian Embassy for a customary meeting with Cd'A Shri Rakesh Tiwari on 15th April. Discussions included International Yoga Day, cultural initiatives, and upcoming festivals.

On 27th April, the Samiti also had the opportunity to meet with the Hon'ble CM of Jharkhand, Shri Hemant Soren, during his visit to Sweden to explore investment opportunities. The Samiti shared insights about Hindu Mandir in Sweden and extended a warm invitation for him to visit the Mandir.

Building & Renovation



GOOD News !!! The Ventilation System which was not functional for many years has been repaired and is fully functional. Thereby saving us investment on a new Ventilation system.

We informed in the previous newsletters about some of the problems in the building. And we have been talking to different companies to get quotations.

Additionally, Mandir's old refrigerator stopped working and a new refrigerator was purchased.

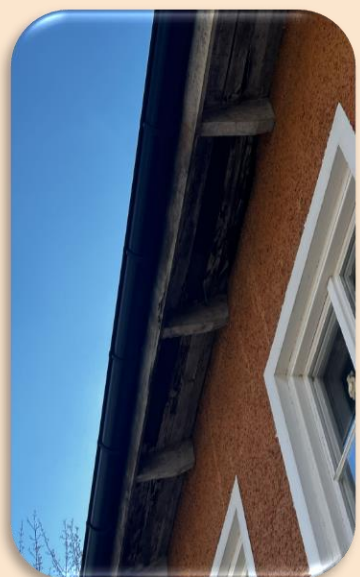


Structural damages to the building

After taking over as Samiti, during the month of April, we have noticed many issues in the building that require urgent remediation, and the Samiti has started talking to different companies to fix the issues.

Following are the issues we have seen so far which needs urgent attention:

1. Rotten roof
2. Skylight window is rotten and water leaking into the room
3. Few roof tiles are missing and some tiles are not properly set.
4. The paint on the external side of windows has peeled off, and raw wood is exposed, if not repainted, will lead to further damage and rot.
5. Plaster and some concrete from few places has fallen - Bhandara room, outside entry etc.



These above specified issues are additional to the list of issues found last month (after taking over) :

1. Bathroom and toilets in Ground floor to be renovated. Vendor finalization in progress
2. Overall painting (inside, outside).
3. Overall decor including Carpets, lights.



We require support from each member/ business to support these large-scale renovation activities. We will release a fundraiser during May-July.
