Festivals and Cultural Activities

Vijayadashmi/Dussehra celebration

Dussehra was celebrated at the Mandir with great energy and devotion. Children dressed as Shri Ram, Lakshman, Sita, and Hanuman brought a special charm to the celebration, filling the atmosphere with bhakti and joy. The event concluded with the symbolic Ravan Dahan, signifying the victory of good over evil.

On the same day, a Balvihar was organized in collaboration with the Chinmaya Mission, offering children an engaging and educational experience. The session was filled with games, arts, and crafts, helping young participants connect with the values of dharma and devotion in a fun and creative way.

Karwa Chauth puja in Mandir

A Karwa Chauth Puja was organized at the Mandir, with many devotees participating in multiple batches throughout the evening. The atmosphere was filled with devotion as married women observed the traditional fast and offered prayers for the well-being and longevity of their spouses.

Choti Diwali celebration

56 Bhog

Pandit Satyavrata Shashtri Ji also narrated the Gowardhan Katha, enriching the occasion with its spiritual significance. The day was marked by collective devotion, joy, and the vibrant spirit of community participation.

Extra Information

- **Pandit Dharmendra Upadhyay Ji returned to India** on 11th October. During his stay, he participated in the events organized by the Mandir, adding a special devotional feeling to each celebration. His presence was warmly appreciated by the community and brought an extra sense of joy and inspiration to all the occasions.
- **Pandit Satyavrat Shastri Ji** visited the Mandir for two weeks and participated in the Diwali Puja as well as the 56-Bhog arranged in the Mandir. His presence added a special spiritual aura to the Mandir, enhancing the devotion and joy of these celebrations for all devotees.



- **Bathroom renovation completed:** We are pleased to share that the Mandir ground floor bathroom renovation has been completed. On the ground floor, one bathroom/WC and two additional WCs are now fully functional, providing improved convenience and facilities for all devotees visiting the Mandir.
- We are happy to share that the **Mandir's main entrance has been reopened following the completion of the bathroom renovation and pipe relining work**. During this period, entry had been temporarily through the garden door, and we sincerely thank all devotees for their patience and support. We warmly invite everyone to now use the main entrance for all visits to the Mandir.
- **WhatsApp group update:**
 - ✓ We have created a new WhatsApp community “Hindu Mandir Stockholm Community” and added both of Mandir’s WhatsApp group in the community. This is to avoid any confusion about the WhatsApp groups.
 - ✓ As first WhatsApp group reached to maximum number of members limit therefore new group was created with name “Hindu Mandir Stockholm (द्वितीय-समूह / Dvitiya-samūha)”. If a new person wants to join Mandir’s group, please ask that person to join this new group (QR on last page)
 - ✓ Same information will be shared on old and new groups.



Operational updates

Renovation status:

Renovation is currently in progress, with multiple tasks being carried out simultaneously. Many selfless devotees continue to be actively involved in these activities, offering their time and skills in the service of the Mandir. The following tasks are completed till now

- ❖ Ground floor bathroom renovation completed. One bathroom/wc and two WC on ground floor are fully functional now.
- ❖ 4 windows broken glasses were replaced by a devotee
- ❖ All Roof related work is done. Detailed update:
 - ✓ Sky light window is replaced
 - ✓ Rotten roof wood is replaced
 - ✓ All broken tiles are changed and misplaced tiles are fixed



Operational updates contd..

Here is the cost breakup for each work:

High-level Renovation Costs (incl. 25% moms) till date. Indicative - subject to final accounts and invoices

One new toilet built on Mandir's ground floor 4. Rebuilding of one existing bathroom/toilet in side building | 480,000 | Includes extra work for damaged pipes |
| Pipe Relining of all underground pipes (kitchen, toilets, changing room, etc) | 260,000 | |
| Ventilation System repair (which was not operational for many years), pipe spolning & standing | 60,000 | |
| Replacement of Roof's underlying rotten wood and damaged tiles | 85,000 | |
| Replacement of roof's damaged skylight window | 25,000 | |
| New carpet for Bhavan | 60,000 | Yet to arrive |
| Paint Material | 45,000 | ongoing |
| Electric fixtures including LED lights, wires, connectors, sockets, switches, etc. | 20,000 | ongoing |
| Tools, accessories, temporary setups during renovation, disposables (plates, cups, boxes, etc.) | 35,000 | ongoing |
| Wall repairs, Shivalya pipe repairs, El central tap & water pipe repairs. other small repairs | 25,000 | ongoing |
| Total | 1, 095, 000 | *indicative |

Note: An insurance claim was submitted for the bathroom renovation and pipe relining work, but it was denied by the insurance company, citing lack of mandatory maintenance and timely repairs over the past several years.



Mandir needs your support

With Ram ji's blessings renovation work is ongoing and some good process has been made. Here is the updated list:

- ✓ Renovation of Toilets and Bathrooms: **Done**
- ✓ Relining of underground pipes and replacing damaged pipes. **Done**
- ✓ Ventilation System repair: **Done**
- Anticimex Treatment (Pest control and hygiene)- Two appointments done. Third one will be scheduled after bathroom renovation is finished. **Ongoing**
- ✓ Roof Repairs and skylight window replacement: **Done**
- Window and Wall Repairs: **Ongoing**
- Painting of Walls and Roof (with help from devotees): **Ongoing**
- Replacement of Lighting with LED fixtures: **Ongoing**
- Carpet Replacement in Main Bhavan: **Order pending**
- Instruments and Equipment for Mandir Bhajans and Aarti: **Planning**
- Essential Tools for Renovation Work: **Buying as needed**
- New Utensils for the Kitchen: **Planning**

The revised **estimated cost** of the total renovation is **1,250,000 SEK**


